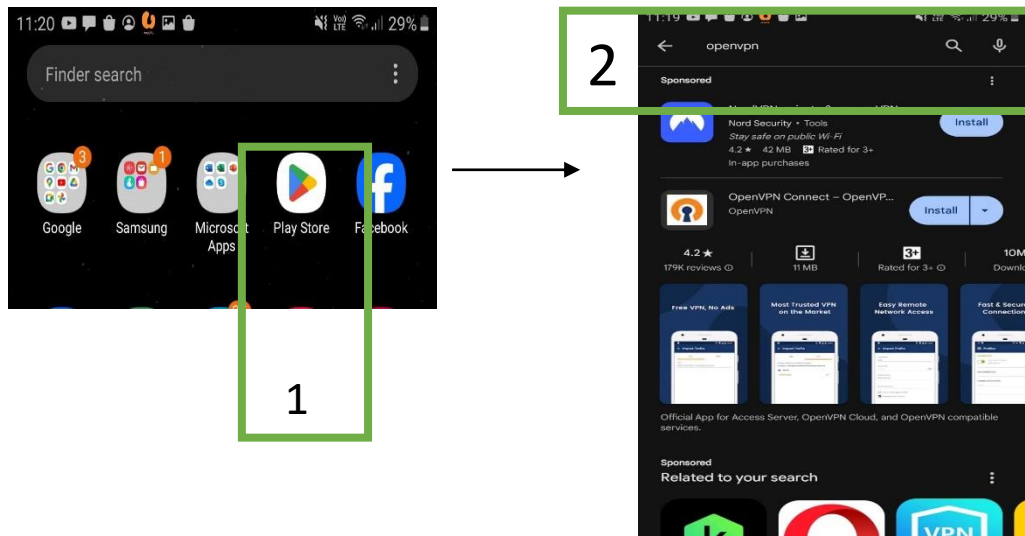
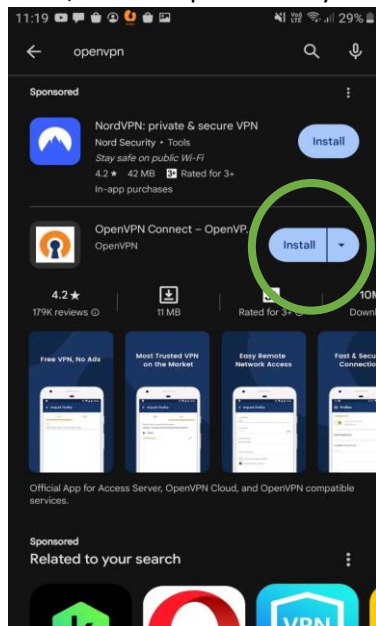


User guideline to install OpenVPN in android with given configuration file.

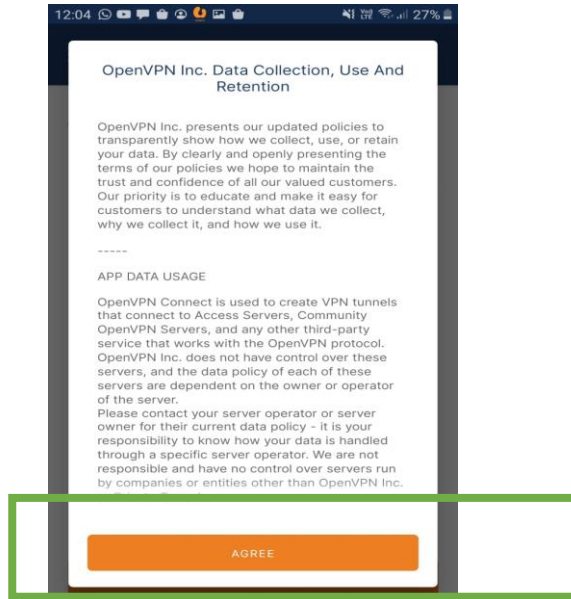
1. Go to play store and search “openvpn”



2. Then, install “OpenVPN” by clicking this icon button

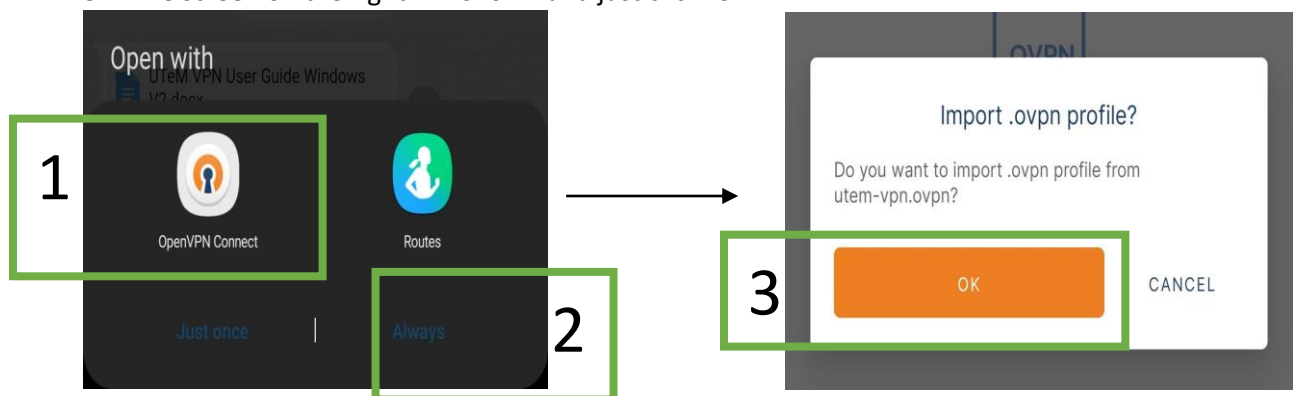


3. Then open the application and just “Agree to the term and condition”



Then, close the application and proceed to step 4.

4. After installing OpenVPN, obtain configuration file by the provided file given from the system administrator.
5. Then, open the configuration file that has been passed from the system administrator. Just as the figure shown below;

 2. Then, click “Always.”
 3. The screen on the right will shown and just click “ok”



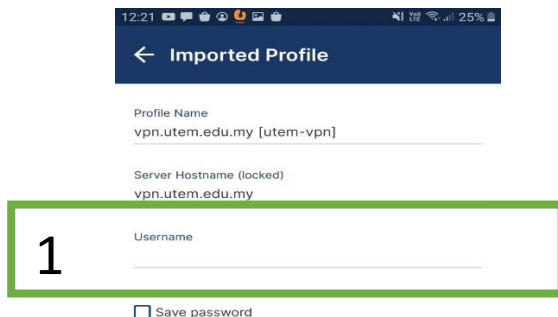
Then we can proceed to step 6.

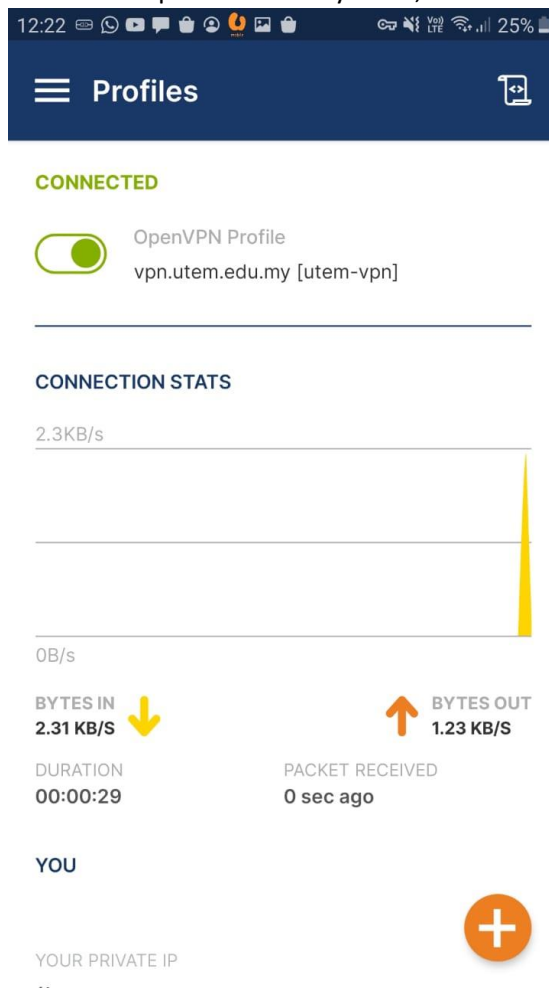
